### THUMBS DOWN TO FINGERPRINTING!

ISS have now introduced biometric finger scanning machinery.

This is not a fingerprint scanner, it is a biometric scanner. It scans the blood vessels under the skin, not just your fingerprint.

Everyone's scan is unique to that person.

# RMT are opposed to automated time and attendance machines.

RMT believe that these machines infringe on workers' civil liberties and their dignity at work.

Apart from this we have no evidence that any personal data collected will be secure in ISS's hands.

Regional Organiser, John Leach and RMT reps have met with ISS and made clear our opposition to the use of this equipment.

We are now balloting our members to take action against the use of the biometric scanning machines.

This is a ballot for action <u>short of strike</u> <u>action</u> we are not asking RMT members to strike at this time. We want members to vote YES for action short of strike action. A YES vote will mean the union can call on members not to use the machines.
