Why are we striking?

The RMT would like to apologise to you today for the disruption to your journey for our strike action which is necessary due to the unreasonable behaviour by London Underground.

What is the strike about?

The issues we are striking about revolve around our working conditions and management breaking our agreements.

⇒ We are striking so you have enough drivers to provide a decent, safe service instead of the current situation whereby London Under-

ground are working drivers on the line into the ground.

⇒ We are striking to be treated with dignity and respect at work and not to be threatened with the sack for taking time off following issues such as suicides in the course of our work.

⇒ We are striking to defend Union agreements and against the constant attacks on drivers on the line during the course of their day to day duties.

What is this strike not about?

This strike is NOT

about money. All our drivers taking industrial action will lose a day's salary.
