It's just the tip of the iceberg...

Job Cuts: Don't be fooled by LU's propaganda - the fact that there are no compulsory redundancies or P45s (as yet!) isn't the point - the loss of positions are job cuts!

And there's more to come. This is merely phase one in an attempt to restructure our job, *root and branch*. Do the maths. LU's recent announcement saves them £16M a year. Yet Boris Johnson and Peter Hendy have already declared that £5BN of savings need to be made across TfL. This amount has just been increased by £460M following the Arbiter's recent report into Tube Lines.

So there are going to be further job losses, redundancies, roster changes, attacks on annual leave, terms and conditions, safety and our pensions. And the attacks will be savage and across *all* grades (see *Across the Tracks Exclusive*).

We have to stop the rot NOW! Lets not kid ourselves - this is not going to be resolved through some clever negotiation. It's a straight fight between *us* and *them*.

They want us to pay for the economic crisis - we need to resist!

We need to move urgently to a united all grades industrial strategy to bring the entire network to a standstill - *for as long as it takes*. Workers across *all* grades and *all* companies - LUL, Metronet and Tube Lines - need to organise now and raise the campaign for strike action.

Where possible we need to co-ordinate with our brothers and sisters fighting job cuts on Network Rail. Maintenance workers on Network Rail have just returned a massive 77% yes vote for strike action. Soon our signallers on Network Rail will also return a massive vote for strike action.

And outside our industry, we need to unite with PCS workers where 270, 000 workers recently staged a 48hr national strike. Further, BA cabin crew workers have just set 7 days of strike action over virtually identical attacks we face.

With the General Election just weeks away in May, all the established political parties are united on one thing: we the workers will have to pay for their economic crisis. We need to make it clear it is we the workers who are the source of the wealth of the nation and it is we who keep this country moving. *We can also bring it to a standstill.*
